Title: An Act Requiring Seatbelts on Public School Buses

- L01:** Article I: Every public school bus in the state of Virginia
L02: should be required to install seatbelts.
L03: Article II: A seatbelt can be defined as a that is used to
L04: hold an individual in his seat. A school bus is defined as
L05: a publicly or privately owned vehicle that transports
L06: students to and from school or school related activities.
L07: A public school is defined as an elementary, middle,
L08: secondary, or high school in the State of Virginia and is
L09: supported by public funds and provides free education for
L10: students eligible to attend such schools.
L11: Article III: This bill will go into effect no later than
L12: September 1st, 2009; the start of the next school year.
L13: Article IV: This bill will be backed by the Virginia PTA, the
L14: National Coalition for School Bus Safety, Fairfax County
L15: Public Schools, the U.S Department of Transportation, and
L16: U.S Department of Education. This bill will be funded for
L17: by taking 1/2 of 1% of the State's Sales Tax Revenue.
L18: Article V: All other laws that conflict with this new policy
L19: are hereby declared null and void.
